On February 4, the Municipal Emergency Services Authority of Lancaster County (MESA; pronounced māy-sah) will begin providing 911 emergency medical services previously provided in your municipality by Northwest EMS.

Like so many EMS agencies, Northwest EMS was facing insolvency due to insufficient revenue and rising costs. MESA is a new publicly funded municipal authority formed to replace Northwest EMS and ensure that 911 ambulance service is available to you and your community on a sustainable basis.

An annual fee charged to property owners and employers will fund MESA and enable 24/7 readiness to respond to EMS calls. Your first annual bill will arrive by mail soon.

- Same outstanding EMS service
- 24/7 readiness to answer 911 EMS calls
- Sustainable, equitable public funding model
- No residual bills for EMS services if your insurance pays
- 50% off EMS bills if you do not have insurance coverage
- 50% off EMS bills if your payment applies to a deductible
